

Station of the Month

Our station this month is the Citizens Fire and Hose Company #1. Formed at a meeting in the Borough Band Hall in Dec. of 1899 with 72 members and incorporated on Jan. 8, 1900. The first Fire Station was a frame building located parallel to the Ma & PA Railroad. The first piece was a Hand Drawn Hose and Chemical Carriage purchased in March 1900. In 1911 a 30 X 60 2 ¹/₂ story building was built on the West side of Main St. and became the new Fire Station.
