#### 2021 SPAAMFAA WINTER CONFERENCE

The Old Fire Farts of York County PA will be hosting the Annual SPAAMFAA WINTER CONFERENCE here in York during March 10<sup>th</sup> through March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The Conference will be held at the Wyndham Garden York Hotel in West Manchester Township. We were awarded to be the host of the Conference last February in N. Charleston, SC before this whole Covid-19 virus came about. It has been a ever changing plan in putting this Conference together but it is looking good for a successful event. As of the end of January we have 74 guest registered with two sold out bus trips and a dinner for 50 people on Saturday evening.

Working with the Hotel, the bus Company, and the Alert Fire Hall it is all coming together with safe precautions for Covid-19 protection. The Hotel and Bus Company are fogging and cleaning spaces and wiping down highly touched areas. There are hand sanitizers throughout the hotel and on the buses. In our guest bags we have included a five pack of cotton masks, personnel hand sanitizer bottles, we have purchased infrared thermometers and will be taking everyone's temperatures before entering a meeting room or a bus. We have arranged social distancing by limiting the number of people in each room and on the buses. Seating will be 10 feet apart at inside gatherings and limited to 25 people or 50% of the assigned capacity. Signage throughout the building and on the buses will remind people of the rules for everyone's safety. Our dinner will have the same social distancing with 50 people in a room that hold 350. With over 70 people attending the Conference and over 50 attending the dinner we have a goal that Safety comes first.
