2023 York County Convention

On August 12, 2023, the West Manchester Township Fire Department will be hosting the Firefighter's Association of York County 111th Annual Convention Parade. The parade will leave the upper parking lot of the Church of the Open Door at 12:00 noon. The parade will proceed west on Loucks Road, left on Taxville Road, left on Bannister Street, and will disband at the West York High School and Middle School. Fire apparatus will continue via normal traffic to the York Expo Center. There will be a reviewing stand with announcers located at the Rutters on Bannister Street.

Traffic for residents and businesses along the route will be affected starting at 11:45 a.m. until approximately 3:00 p.m. There will be access points staffed by fire police to allow access to and from local neighborhoods impacted by the road closure.
